Identify gender-related programme objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Which objectives are targeting women directly ✓ Which objectives have the potential to target women
Prepare output indicators for the identified objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ What is the scope or potential base ✓ What are the number of women beneficiaries ✓ Number of women provided employment
Identify activities targeted to reach the above outputs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ What are the physical targets for those activities ✓ What is the budget for those activities ✓ Is there any percentage allocation for women specified in the guidelines
Review Actual performance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Physical target vs achievement in last 3 years ✓ Target vs achievement for women allocations in last 3 years ✓ Budget allocation vs utilization in last 3 years
Review Budget adequacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ What is the total budget required to solve the problem ✓ If it was to be solved in 5 years- what would be the annual budget requirement ✓ Budget allocation trends in last 5 years ✓ Adequacy of unit costs
Specific initiatives for reaching out to women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ What activities are proposed ✓ What is the status of implementation of those activities ✓ Is there any budget allocation/ utilization of those activities ✓ Are women provided employment as part of the programme ✓ Are women part of the decision making forums
